CLINICAL EXPERIENCE

I. Operative Training:

I received adequate surgical training and performed many operations as:

- Plating of fractured bones of the upper and lower limbs.

- Hip hemiarthroplasty including Austin-Moore, cemented Thompson and bipolar arthroplasty.
- Hip and knee arthroplasty
- Interlocking Nailing of tibia, femur and humerus.
- External Fixation in case of open fracture.
- Knee arthroscopy for partial meniscectomy, ACL reconstruction
- Shoulder arthroscopy for decompression, rotator cuff repair, Bankart repair, Remplissage technique, Latarjet, SLAP, arthroscopic bone blocks for instabilities, suprascapular nerve release.
- Shoulder arthroplasty including anatomical and reverse and posttraumatic arthroplasties.
- Correction of deformities as genu varum, cubitus varus and malunited fracture.

I also had the chance to assist my consultants in major operations as revision THR, revision TKR, fixation of fracture acetabulum, tumors of the bone.

II. Out patients' Clinics

In Annecy, I worked in the upper limb outpatient clinic. This clinic was twice weekly and the number of patients attending this clinic was over 350 patients per month.

During my residency, I worked in the outpatient orthopedic surgery Clinics of Alexandria University Hospitals. This clinic was once weekly and under the supervision of my consultants. The number of patients attending this clinic was about 800 patients per month.

III. Care of patients in the ward:

As a fellow in Annecy, I was responsible for the preoperative and postoperative ward round.

As a resident, I performed the daily ward rounds in the Orthopedic Department at Alexandria University Hospitals. I was responsible for 36 beds. I also took part in the on-call rota which was 1 to 2 in the first year residency and became 1 to 4 in the third year.

IV. Clinical Meetings:

I had the opportunity to be among the organizing committee of the Annecy Live Surgery International Advanced Shoulder Course that was held in Annecy, France in June 2009, June 2011, and June 2013.

I organised 6 MSI courses with the other fellows in Annecy France. I also organized monthly departmental clinical meetings at El-Hadra University Hospital. I gave a number of clinical presentations in these meetings.

V. Teaching:

I had the chance to teach the opinion leaders of shoulder surgery in Italy the procedure of Arthroscopic Latarjet. During my stay in Italy as a Consultant of J&J, I had the chance to visit many centres across Italy and teach big Italian shoulder surgeons this difficult technique.

My teaching experience includes also postgraduate and undergraduate Orthopaedic teaching to Alexandria University sixth year medical students. This includes teaching in ward rounds, demonstration of clinical skills, and teaching in the out-patient clinics as well as tutorials.

I also participate in the teaching of Senior House Officers and residents. I regularly contribute to work-based learning for nurses.

VI. Administrative Skills:

As a resident, Assistant Lecturer and Consultant, I have organised the duty and on-call rota in Alexandria University Hospitals. I have organised patients' admissions and participated in organising the daily operative lists. I have also organised the clinical and teaching meetings, and participated in conducting end of term exams and oral exams at the end of the academic year for sixth year medical students in Alexandria Medical School and also for postgraduate orthopaedic exams.
